LIMITED DISTANCE & COMPETITIVE

25 Miles each day (LD's may Elevate to the 50 per Elevator ride rules)

Fees: \$70/day (Juniors \$35/day)

(LD: non-AERC members add \$15/day)

General Info and Camp Directions (there is a daily per person camping fee)

All rides will conform to UMECRA and AERC standards. GLDRA and OAATS sanctioned.

All horses on site must have a current Coggins. All judges' decisions are final.

Special awards given for Monday through Friday Shore to Shore 250 or 125 horse/rider completions

South Branch Trail Camp: From jct. of M-65 and River Road (~23 mi W of Oscoda) go West 4.2 mi to Rollways Road, then North 2.4 mi to camp entrance on right. **THIS IS “BASE CAMP” FOR SATURDAY, SUNDAY, and MONDAY rides, and we leave there for good on Tuesday morning.**

River Road Trail Camp: From Oscoda, travel West on River Road ~10 miles to camp on Left. **THIS CAMP IS CLOSED, AND WILL ONLY BE OPENED AND USED FOR THE START OF THE 50-MILE RIDE ON MONDAY! STARTING RIDE CAMP IS SOUTH BRANCH CAMP, AND 50-MILERS WILL HAVE TO TRAILER TO THIS CAMP TO START MONDAY MORNING. \$10 DISCOUNT FOR 50-MILERS THIS DAY ONLY.**

Luzerne Trail Camp: From Luzerne, go South 1.9 mi on Durfee Rd, then Left $\frac{3}{4}$ mi to camp on left

Goose Creek Trail Camp: West on M-72 out of Grayling 5.5 mi after intersection with M-93, then right on Manistee River Road 6.2 mi to camp on left

Sheck’s Trail Camp: West out of Kalkaska 7.8 mi after McDonalds, then right on Supply Rd for 6.2 mi then left on Brown Bridge Rd for 3.7 mi to camp on left

Garey Lake Trail Camp: About 8 mi East of Empire on M-72, turn South onto Maple City Rd and go ~2 mi to Pettengill Rd. Turn right, and go 2.4 mi to camp on left.

SPECIAL NOTES:

- As stated above, 50-mile riders on Monday, August 5 will have to trailer to the start. Rig or trailer-pooling is encouraged. All 50-mile riders that day will get \$10 off of their ride fees to help defray this expense/inconvenience.
- It is strongly suggested that you bring at least 2 (more is recommended) plastic buckets with good/tight (e.g. screw-on) lids for water transport to vet-checks.
- A set of “Driver’s Directions” will be available at the ride, and can be emailed to you beforehand if requested.
